This spectacular 3-day showcase by 160 of the country's most talented artists, craftspeople, and entertainers is centered on historic Columbus Circle in downtown Syracuse. More than 40,000 visitors will shop and browse among the art and craft exhibits and enjoy a wide variety of music, multi-cultural performances, summer refreshments, and participatory activities.

#### **Arts & Crafts**

The festival presents an exceptionally wide selection of contemporary arts and crafts, ranging from functional to decorative. Exhibitors will be drawn from throughout the entire U.S. and Canada.

#### **Performing Arts**

The festival also features the performing arts. A full schedule of free continuous entertainment will include street performances by musicians, costumed ethnic dance groups, and local singer/songwriters.

#### **Family Activities**

Families play a big role in the event's success, and participatory activities are offered with them in mind. Interactive projects allow young visitors the opportunity to create their own works of art.

#### **Summer Refreshments**

Nearly a dozen food vendors will be on site to serve up a diverse mix of summer favorites.

#### **A Community Festival**

Centered on an historic park in downtown Syracuse, the event allows area businesses to benefit from the exposure to thousands of visitors. Area churches hold open houses and sell refreshments. Other activities include family art activities, an antique show, and a very popular sidewalk art competition.

Several of these activities are presented in cooperation with not-for-profit, cultural, educational, or charitable organizations downtown, including the Everson Museum of Art, the Onondaga Historical Association, and the YMCA.

The Syracuse Arts & Crafts Festvial runs concurrently with the Northeast Jazz & Wine Festival in Clinton Square. Thousands of visitors will attend both events, making this the signature cultural event of the summer in Syracuse.

#### **Regulations:**

**Vendor Booths:** Sponsors and Vendors will be assigned spaces and must limit their display to the designated space. Vendors must provide their own tents, displays, tables, chairs, etc. All tents must be weighted. No tent stakes will be allowed.

Set-Up: Set up may begin on Thursday, July 25 after 6 pm or on Friday, July 26 after 6 am. Vendor is required to keep sidewalks and walkways clear of cords, cables, and ropes.

**Certificate of Insurance:** All Vendors must carry \$1,000,000 general liability insurance and provide Certificates of Insurance naming the Downtown Committee of Syracuse, Inc., 115 W. Fayette St., Syracuse, NY 13202, and the City of Syracuse, 412 Spencer St., Syracuse, NY 13204 as additional insured.

**Electricity:** Availability of electrical power is limited in the festival area. Please indicate below if you require electrical power. Vendors must supply their own 100-foot, 12/3 grounded wire extension cords.

Festival Hours of Operation:Vendors must be set up and open for operation by opening time through closing time each day.Friday, July 26 - 10 am to 6 pmSaturday, July 27 - 10 am to 5 pmSunday, July 28 - 10 am to 5 pm

**Vehicles:** Vehicles will not be allowed in the festival area during the hours of operation. Parking is available at several nearby lots at Vendor's expense. If restocking is necessary during the hours of operation, it must be done with your own handcart.

**Security:** The festival provides 24-hour roving security through the area during the festival hours and overnight on Thursday, Friday and Saturday. The Downtown Committee of Syracuse assumes no responsiblity for lost, damaged, or stolen items. The Vendor is responsible for protecting their own product, supplies, and equipment.

By signing this agreement, you hereby release and forever discharge the Downtown Committee of Syracuse, Inc., the City of Syracuse, the County of Onondaga, all sponsoring organizations, and their directors, officers, employees, agents and volunteers from any responsibility, personal liability, claims, loss or damage arising out of your application and/or participation in the Syracuse Arts & Crafts Festival.
